The Good Neighbor Scholarship Program provides an exemption of tuition for students from other nations of the Western Hemisphere (other than Cuba or the United States). Students may be awarded one year of tuition (fall, spring, and summer).

- Students are exempt from paying tuition only. Students must still pay applicable fees. •
- Students must be on a current United States Immigration Service approved "Student Visa" (Usually F-1 or J-1).
- Students must have been born in and be a current resident of one of the politically independent nations in the American Hemisphere, listed below. ٠
- Students must intend to return to their eligible country upon completion of the program of study.
- Students must be unconditionally admitted to UTSA and maintain satisfactory academic progress.
- Undergraduates must take a minimum of 12 hours each semester. Graduate students must take a minimum of 9 hours each semester.
