

2021-2022 Request for Preparatory Coursework

Directions: Non-degree-seeking students are not eligible to receive federal financial aid. There is one exception: you may request financial aid for preparatory coursework for up to one academic year. This request is subject to approval by the UTSA Financial Aid and Scholarships Office. If approved, you will be awarded a Direct Unsubsidized Stafford Loan based on undergraduate loan limits.

How to Submit Form: Submit completed form to One Stop Enrollment Center for processing. Preparatory coursework is defined as courses a student must take in order to be admitted as a degree-seeking student to a graduate/professional program. Students who have been fully admitted as graduate students and are required to take prerequisite or leveling courses that do not count towards their degree are **not** eligible for financial aid for these courses. This form can be submitted by mail, in-person at the One Stop Enrollment Center, or via the [Document Uploader](#).

PREPARATORY COURSEWORK QUALIFICATIONS

Note: *If you do not meet these conditions, you may not qualify for financial aid.*

- You must have a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on file with UTSA for 2021-2022
- You must be a non-degree seeking student
- You must be enrolled at least half-time
- You must not be taking preparatory courses to raise your GPA
- You may only receive financial aid for up to one academic year for preparatory coursework
- You must fill out this form each semester
