The University of Texas at San Antonio acknowledges that it has signed and returned to the U.S. Department of Education the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that it will use the applicable amounts of Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds (HEERF) I, II, and III designated under the CARES Act, Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations (CRRSA) Act, and American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act, signed into law by Presidents Donald Trump and Joe Biden, to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.

Enrolled for the semester they are seeking funds

Award amounts ranged from \$500, \$1,000, \$1500.

Student who get a block grant can only get 1 additional Emergency Aid application grant per semester.
